Roland Hinzer was born in 1964 in Riedholz, SO, Switzerland. He was drawn to the Upper Engadine at an early age, where, after six years of working with the architects J. Troxler and W. Wichser, he set up his own business at the age of 36 and founded Hinzer Architektur und Baumanagement based in Champfèr in 2001. He has been CEO of Hinzer Architektur AG since 2012. Over the years he has held various administrative mandates and public offices in the Engadine, including as municipal councilor of Pontresina.

In 2017, the architectural firm hwa Architekten AG was founded in Zurich together with Ivo Weinhardt. In addition to many individual new buildings, conversions and sensitive renovations of old buildings, both for private builders as well as hotel and restaurant businesses, Roland Hinzer also specializes in the latest building technology and thermal renovation. He acquired a special qualification for this in previous courses at the Bern engineering schools as a civil engineer HTL and Chur in building physics and energy/building technology.
